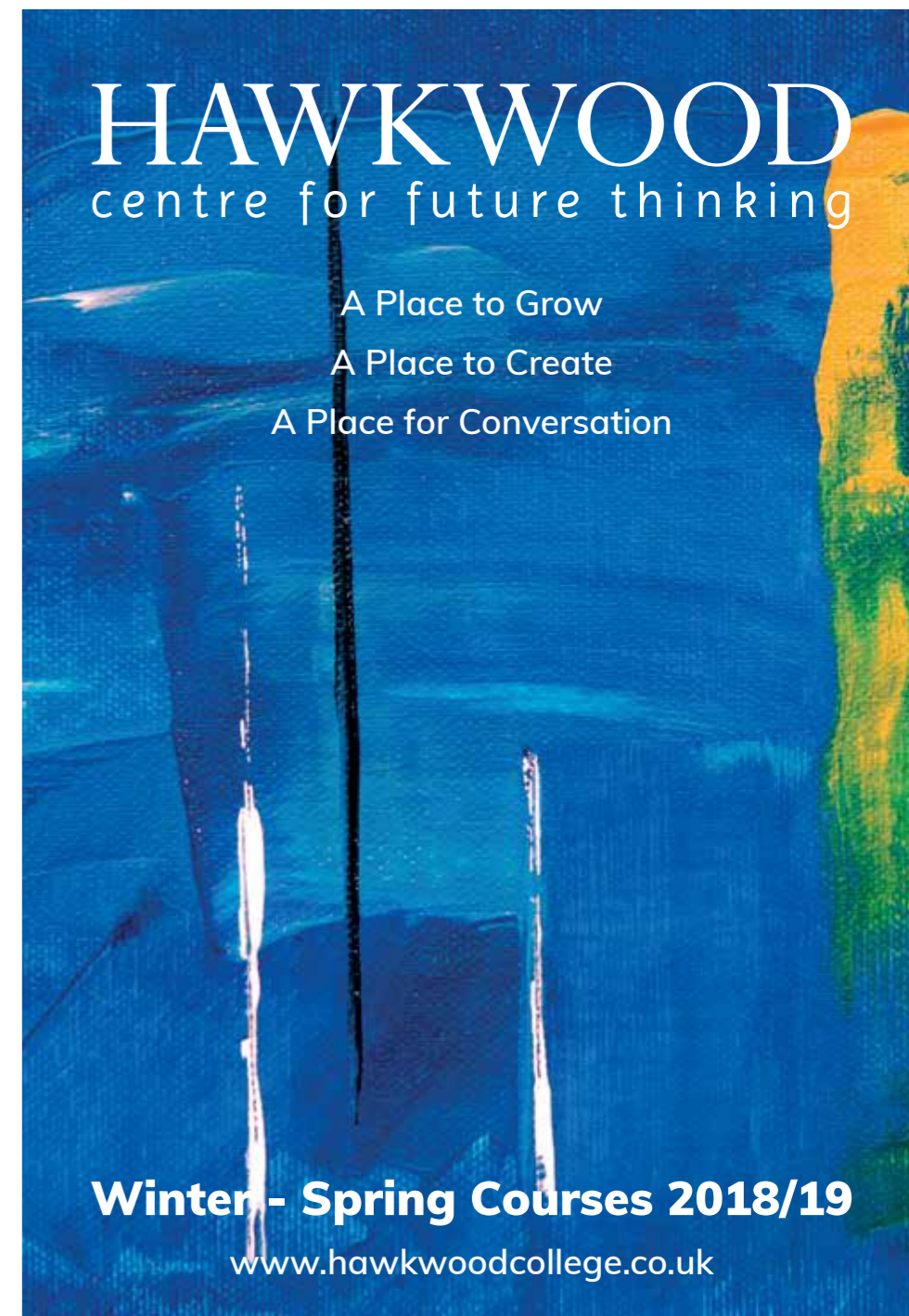
Residency Programme
