


surroundings

Hawkwood is surrounded by forty two acres overlooking the Severn Vale. Ten acres of sustainably managed woodland bounds the estate, twenty acres of grass land are managed by Stroud Community Agriculture and the gardens consists of a Victorian half-walled garden growing fruit, vegetables, herbs and flowers for use within the house. There is an award winning pond and wetlands system on site, while the mature ornamental grounds, with a magnificent sycamore standing beside the constantly flowing Hawkwood spring.

Tucked away in the woods situated behind the house is the Woodland Sanctuary, a place for quiet and stillness, available for use by Hawkwood guests.

All of this is set in an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, Hawkwood is a wonderfully peaceful location.

how to find us

by car

If coming by car: From the west and north, take Exit 13 off the M5 and follow signs to Stroud centre. From the east, take Exit 15 off the M4 and follow the A419 past Cirencester to Stroud. If coming from the Oxford area, follow the A429 or B4425 off the A40 to Cirencester. Follow the A419 from Cirencester as above.

From Stroud centre, follow the A46, then the Painswick Old Road (which is signposted ‘to Wick St.’). Please contact us if you would like more detailed instructions (also included on confirmation forms sent after booking).

by train

If coming by train, take a taxi from the Stroud train station (max.2 miles). For hiking enthusiasts, it takes approximately half an hour by foot!

by plane

If coming by plane, the closest airports are Bristol and Heathrow. Take a taxi from Bristol, or take the bus/train from Heathrow to Stroud (approx. travel time 2.5 hrs.). From Stroud train station, take a taxi to Hawkwood (2 miles).

Hawkwood is located in a Grade II listed 19th Century country house, surrounded by 42 acres of sustainably managed woodland, farmland and gardens, all overlooking the Severn Vale. Set in an area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, Hawkwood is an inspiring and wonderfully peaceful location in which to host your course, meeting or event.

The property offers 29 bedrooms which can sleep up to 50 people, many have original features and views over the garden. There are 5 meeting rooms of different sizes in the main house, plus 2 studios in the converted stable. Hawkwood has a commitment to locally sourced and organically grown food, including growing salads, herbs and flowers in the Victorian half walled garden.

All of this is within easy reach of both the M4 and M5 motorways. Delegate packages can be tailored to suit groups from 6 to 100 people.

function rooms

Main Hall Room size 13.7m x 6.7m

With wonderful views, this room is the perfect place to host your functions or meetings. It holds up to 95 people in a lecture format.



Sitting Room Room size 7.3m x 5.8m

This room benefits from the original fireplace and striking architectural features. Ideal for medium sized groups, it can hold up to 15 people.



Library Room size 6.7m x 5.5m

As well as a fully functioning library with a beautiful log burner this room also makes for an ideal place to work in comfort, or to enjoy a more sociable setting and holds up to 20 people.



The Blue Room Room size 6.7m x 5.5m

The perfect setting for smaller discussion groups or board meetings. Holds up to 30 people in lecture format.

Room One Room size 4.8m x 3.6m

Ideal for small meetings holding up to 6 people, or as a therapy room.



Studio One Room size 9.7m x 5.2m

Holds up to 40 people in lecture format. The room is also perfectly suited for craft activities or movement.



Studio Two Room size 6.1m x 5.5m

Holds up to 20 people in lecture format. This formal meeting room can be adapted to create a relaxed, informal and comfortable space using optional lounge chairs.



accommodation

Hawkwood can accommodate up to 50 guests within 13 single rooms, 1 double room, 12 twin rooms and 4 triple rooms. These warm, comfortable rooms with original features enjoy views across the valley or onto the gardens. All rooms are fitted with hand basins, and bathrooms and toilets are located nearby on each floor.
