## **Materials List for Sketching in the Garden from Alison Vickery**

This is a guide; as long as you have a selection of materials along these lines you will be fine. Alison will also have a selection of materials with her to lend and paper, which she will sell at cost.

- **Paper** – a few sheets of A3 watercolour paper (Alison uses Bockingford 300g cold pressed or similar)
  - Cartridge paper, again a few sheets of A3
  - A piece of A3 coloured mid tone paper
- A light weight drawing board (Alison often uses the card from the back of a pad)
- Masking tape, clips or rubber bands
- A couple of pencils 2B and softer and a rubber
- Dip pen, quill or stick
- Drawing ink - one colour
- Felt tip and/or biro
- Watercolour brush – one good round approx. size 8 or 10 with a good point is an excellent starting point
- Watercolours, pans or tubes. Suggested colours: lemon yellow, cadmium yellow, burnt umber, cadmium red, alizarin crimson, cobalt blue, cerulean blue and a dark blue such as indigo or Prussian
- White gouache
- Water pot and a bottle
- Pallet
- Kitchen towel
- A light weight chair or stool will give you more choice of where to sit
- Suitable clothing for the vagaries of the English summer
